
Life certainly has it's ups and downs. Down Syndrome; the diagnosis I never wanted has become the "gift" that has transformed me the most.


But the most exciting addition is an internship at a preschool here in Lawrence, where Bethany will be helping teach the 3,4 year old class! #DreamsComeTrue
